Things to remember:

- Injections – Hepatitis, Tetanus. Consult your doctor. No malaria needed, except when traveling to the eastern parts of South Africa, like Kruger National Park. Contact VOTG for help with vaccines – 1 800 268 8684 www.vaccinesonthegeo.com
- Register your guns and valuable equipment (Cameras, Binoculars) with US Customs and get a [Form 4457](#) (Max. 2 guns, and no semi or automatic guns) Keep registration with you on the plane.
- Fill in form [SAPS 520](#), but do not sign it. Only sign it in front of the Police Officer at Johannesburg Int'l Airport when claiming your guns.
- Payment Method: Wire Transfer, Credit Card (Visa, MasterCard or AMEX), or Cash (NO MORE CHECKS)**
- Notify your bank and credit card company that you'll be traveling abroad so they won't suspect foreign transactions made with your credit card.
- Know your credit card's pin number, if you want to withdraw cash from an ATM.
- Travel insurance. Try www.medjetassistance.com or www.sportsmanstravelinsurance.com
- Insurance on guns and equipment. See www.siai.net or www.tic.com
- Passport. Check your expiration date. And you need two blank consecutive pages in it for RSA stamps. No Visa needed for US Citizens.
- Your arrival/departure point is Johannesburg**
- Plane tickets.** Two airlines fly daily direct to South Africa, **South African Airways** – www.flysaa.com – from JFK or Washington Dulles (IAD) **Delta Airlines** – www.delta.com – from Atlanta (ATL)

- Guns and ammo. 60 rounds per gun would be enough. *No Semi or Automatic rifles. No rifles of the same caliber per person.*
- Pack ammo separate from guns, in original factory boxes, and some airlines also require a “locked metal container”, like a Cash Box from WalMart. Pack it so that it can be reached easily, for you will have to take it out for inspection. **Total amo weight not more than 11 lbs.** 3 boxes per caliber is save.
- If you that don't want to stand in line to register your guns in South Africa, I highly recommend that you get in touch with Hunterspermitsafrica; they are a South African based company that will handle all your import papers for your guns. Contact Adele @ hunterspermitsafrica@telkomsa.net*
- Binoculars
- Cameras – Remember spare batteries. We do have converters in every room.
- Toiletries
- Personal Medicine & Prescriptions
- Hunting boots – 2 pairs, well worn.
- Hunting clothes – 2 pairs. Camo's are allowed in South Africa. If you like to wear shorts those zip-off pants are perfect.
- Casual wear for around the campfire.
- 2 Jackets. The best is to put on layers and take them off when it heat up during the day. Morning and evenings cool.
